## **Application and Rules**

- 1. Teachers are required to complete the application form with photocopy of examination result (see the attached application form). To RSVP, please indicate the number of guests for each student.
- It is the teacher's responsibility to ensure that all information provided is correct, including a clear email address, and that the application is received by the designated deadline - Sunday February 4,
   2018. Submission by students or parents will not be accepted. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.
- 3. For each grade of each instrument, a trophy will be given to those who received the highest mark for the designated exam period. For grade 8 or above, scholarships will also be granted to each trophy winner. Trophies and scholarships will be presented at the end of the recital and can be accepted at that time by student recipients ONLY. Teachers, parents, relatives or friends are ineligible to accept awards on behalf of the winners. If a winner fails to perform in the concert, no trophy or scholarship will be awarded.
- 4. All the trophy recipients will be eligible to perform in the recital. Other participating students will be selected to perform at the discretion of the recital committee. Our recital committee will inform teachers of their successful applicants by Sunday, February 11, 2018. Teachers are required to provide the information of the performance piece to Eva Ye by Sunday, February 18, 2018. Each student may only perform one piece or one movement of a multi-part work within the required time limits.

Please note that pieces should be fairly short and attractive. In consideration of our younger participants, please choose inspiring music. **Students are required to play from memory**. No repeats should be played. Please arrange accompanist if needed.

#### **Maximum Performing Time**

Grade 1 to 7 3 minutes
Grade 8 to Diploma 8 minutes

- 5. All the participating teachers and students will be honoured in the recital program. A recognition certificate will be given to the participating students at the recital.
- 6. Since the recital is to celebrate and showcase the good work and achievement of both students and teachers, please show respect to the event, to all the performers and to the venue where we host it. Teachers are asked to instruct students about stage deportment such as bowing, walking on and off the stage and proper concert attire.
- 7. **The recital committee must be notified of any cancellations.** Students should arrive at the venue **not later than 15 minutes** before the recital begins and must **report to our representative** upon arrival.
- 8. Parents and friends are requested to stay until the recital is finished and to observe proper concert decorum.
- 9. Use of cameras and video recorders is at the discretion of the recital committee and the recital host. **No flash cameras** will be allowed during the performance.
