The BCRMTA Vancouver Branch *Winter Student Recital* will be held on **Sunday, December 9, 2018** at Unitarian Church of Vancouver. It welcomes all active members to send their students to this recital.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Each participating teacher must complete the *Recital Entry Form*, and submit to: **Recital Convenor: Haiwa Ye by email at yehaiwapiano@gmail.com** before the deadline of **Friday, November 9, 2018**. **No late entries in any format will be accepted.**
2. All information on the *Student Recital Entry Form* must be completed. Please also include information regarding the Accompanist/Ensemble player. **The Recital Committee respectfully asks for complete, clear and legible entries of repertoire. No changes will be made after deadline.**
3. Recital pieces chosen should be fairly short and inspiring with a 5 minute maximum playing time. The level should be from prep/Level 1 to ARCT levels. **Students MUST play from memory** without repeats except in the case of da capos. Each student is allowed to play ONE piece or a single movement from a multi-movement work except for **Level 2 or below** students, who are allowed to play TWO pieces. Ensembles are welcome, although, please note that there will be only one piano at the venue. Accompanists must use original scores.
4. Teachers may submit up to 7 separate pieces with a maximum time 15 minutes. As noted earlier the maximum time for each repertoire is 5 minutes.
5. **Participating Teachers are asked to volunteer as usher or door attendant.** Please check off your preferred duty on the entry form. You will be assigned a duty during your students' performances.
6. Teachers are expected to instruct students about stage deportment (bow, walking, no running, no speaking or whispering during other performances). **Appropriate attire is required for ALL performers: boys - shirts, dress pants, dress shoes; girls - shirts/blouses, dresses, dress pants, dress shoes. Performance will be prohibited if the dress code is not observed.**
7. **There is to be NO PHOTOGRAPHY OR RECORDING during any performances;** it disturbs the audience as well as the performers. Please enjoy the moment. Pictures may be taken at the piano, after the recital is finished.
8. Please try to keep cancellations to a minimum, any withdrawals must be made at least 24 hours with the Recital Convenor. Late comers or cancellations without notification will be treated as "no shows". All parents, students and friends are expected to stay for the entire Recital to observe concert decorum.
9. All performers must arrive at least 10 minutes before the recital starts and sit down at the front of the hall according to performance order from the program.
10. The Student Recital Convenor will email the program to all the teachers by **Friday November 30, 2018**. It is the responsibility of the teacher to provide information to their student(s) as to the time, date, venue and the order their student(s) will be performing.
