

BC Registered Music Teachers' Association - Vancouver Branch 2018 Bursary Guidelines

- Objectives** To assist the students of BCRMTA Vancouver Branch members who show potential in their music studies and who demonstrate a need for financial assistance.
- Bursaries** Approximately **\$3500** will be awarded according to the discretion of the Bursary Committee. Grade levels are based on the RCME system. Teachers must make adjustments to apply RCM standards to alternative examination systems.

- Deadline** All submissions must be delivered to the Bursary Convenor, Carol Hung, at 45 Rangelagh Ave, Burnaby B.C. V5B 3N2 by **10:00pm May 31st, 2018.**

General Requirements for the Junior, Intermediate, and Senior Categories

1. Applicants must be 19 years old or younger as of December 31, 2018 and Canadian citizens or landed immigrants.
2. Applicants must have studied a minimum of 1 year (12 months) with a BCRMTA Vancouver Branch teacher in good standing, and they must have the intention to continue their music lessons with this same individual.
3. The BCRMTA Vancouver Branch teacher noted on the application must have been a member in good standing for a minimum of two consecutive years (24 months).
4. Applicants are to complete and submit the following documents before the noted deadline:
 - a) Bursary Application Form
 - b) Bursary Student Evaluation Form(s)
 - c) Supporting documents:
 - i. a budget of the student's proposed course of music study for the 2018/2019 school year using the template provided
 - ii. a letter of reference from their current BCRMTA Vancouver Branch teacher(s)
 - iii. a letter of support from their parents or legal guardians
 - iv. a copy of Canada Revenue Agency Notice of Assessment (form T451E), *Please blackout your SIN; all information will remain confidential and will be destroyed or reclaimed once the application process is complete.*
 - v. and additional information as noted below for the **Senior Category only**.
5. Bursaries are made payable to the teacher of the successful applicants and are neither transferable nor refundable.
6. Recipients of bursaries are required to write a note of acknowledgement upon receiving the award.
7. Bursaries will not be awarded to the same individual two years in a row.

*Additional Requirements for the Senior Category

8. Applicants must indicate on the bursary application form their intention to pursue higher education in the field of music.
9. Applications must include a letter of reference from a qualified professional musician other than their current teacher(s).
10. Post-secondary school applicants must provide proof of registration from an accredited and recognized post-secondary music institution or music faculty before the bursary will be distributed.
